THE GOLDEN RULE - The Christian Preamble

Every country has a constitution and the constitution has a preamble which summarises the spirit of the constitution. India's preamble goes like this, "WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a [SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC] and to secure to all its citizens: JUSTICE, social, economic and political; LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship; EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them all FRA-TERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the [unity and integrity of the Nation] This sums up the entire document in a nutshell. If you ask our Lord Jesus Christ, this question on what the Law (The Tanakh and Torah) are all about?



He would give the reply as what we call the Golden Rule. "So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the Law and the Prophets." (Matthew 7:12 NIV) Christianity is a reflection of our relationship with God. It's a mission based model. An idle christian who is selfish, narcissist and consumeristic is never a Christian in the first place. When we come out of our comfort zones and decide to live a a Christian, the world would change for the better. In the CoVID times, none of us can be silent. We have a work to do and that is to be the light of the world (Matthew 5:14) and to be the salt of the earth (Matthew 5:13).

The Jewish nation was given the law as Moses came down from Sinai but before even they could see or understand it, Moses had to break the stone tablets. The sinful nature of man could not handle the Holy Laws of God. They had 613 of it and by the law, no one could justify themselves before God. St James said, "For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it." (James 2:10) When we hear the condition of the migrant workers, when we hear of untouchability and racism ruling our towns and streets, when we hear of inhumane torture in the confinement of prison, when we see and hear of indignified disposal of human bodies affected by covid-we understand the principle that we are all law breakers and we can't stand justified before a Holy God unless He reckons it to us. (Psalm 32:1) How important it is to understand the grace of God. When we believe and confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, and appropriate that or mirror that truth in our relationships and walks of life-we stand justified by faith through grace.(Rom 10:9, Gal 2:15,Rom 5:1)

James brings clarity to the argument in his epistle. "In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead. But someone will say, "You have faith; I have deeds." Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by my deeds. You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that —and shudder. You foolish person, do you want evidence that faith without deeds is useless?"(Jam 2:17-20) So Christianity is all about living what you are believing and the priority is one another. That's how the law and prophets would be fulfilled in our lives. Even if we don't preach a sermon, when we live out the golden rule, it will bring nations to the saving grace of our Lord Jesus. This can only happen when our Lord Jesus dwells inside of us by the power of His Spirit. Our deeds should not be response oriented, it should be a reflection of who lives in us. The Love poured out by the Holy Spirit in us is not just for a category of people, but its even for the worst of our enemies. "Love your enemies, bless them that curse you" (Matt 5:44) Can we take a decision to practise the Golden Rule and see lives being transformed by the Lord Jesus living in us? Take a moment now and pray. "Dear Lord, give me the strength to practise the golden rule to do to others what I would want them to do for me. Give me the grace and ability for it all comes from you. In Jesus' name we pray-Amen"

This was the promise that God spoke to me while I was a part of the Church 3-day fasting and prayer sessions in the month of Sept 2019. Though at the time we didn't know what the promise meant, we were soon thrilled to find out that I was pregnant with our second child. But little did we understand how much we needed to trust the Lord as turbulent times awaited us. God was faithful in keeping His promise of love and protection over my health and the baby's throughout the pregnancy. Towards the end of March, we were told due to the widespread of the COVID 19 virus, the hospital we were consulting will not be entertaining any patients for 2 weeks up until the lockdown ends. I was very much worried when the lockdown kept extending and I got no response from either the hospital or the doctor. Added to that our street became a containment zone and every other hospital I tried to consult turned me down because of shortage of staff and the pandemic situation we were in.


When every road seemed closed and desperation made us so weary, the only place we found strength was in the Body of Christ. By now our Church was connecting online for weekly prayers, Bible study and weekend services via Skype, YouTube, zoom. Every meeting I was a part of, the Lord spoke through His servant that, 'Angels will be stationed at the time of delivery. Everything is already taken care of by God. You only need be still.'. Everytime we felt hopeless and anxious, the Lord used the church congregation to strengthen and encourage me. Loving sisters and brothers in Christ who called, messaged, prayed and ministered to me with their words of comfort and love. On 31st of May, Sunday, the Day of Pentecost or Shavout, we got admitted in the hospital as the labour pains started. Because of the steep rise in COVID 19 cases, I had to be alone in the hospital, there was very minimal staff working then. Even throughout that stressful time, God reminded of his promises and I knew I wasn't alone as the church was constantly praying for me. Though the labor progressed, the doctor said the baby hasn't descended and it may take much longer and left for home. I knew I couldn't take it any longer and from that hospital bed I cried out to God, to have mercy on me, His handmaid, and the baby and give us life. God was gracious and heard every prayer made on my behalf. The delivery, which the doctor predicted

would take a couple of more hours, took place within 6 minutes, in a miraculous and supernatural way. The baby was born safe and healthy to the suprise of the entire hospital. The doctor and her assistants were amazed. She later testified that she never had anyone deliver before she even arrived.

Through it all I saw the hand of God and His tender mercies over my life. Over and over again I'm overwhelmed by the love, prayers and encouragement I recieved from Pastor, Pastoramma and the Church family. Even in the most darkest of times, I thank God for His church that shines bright and its love that always keeps giving, ministering, even in the midst of a pandemic lockdown. All glory to His name.

This is really exciting for me because when I view it from this perspective I relate with Joseph in Genesis 50:20 But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this day, to save many people alive. Our God is a Big God, His plans are wonderful not because my household is not affected by the Virus but because I say with Apostle Paul, in Romans 12:15 (NIV) Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn. And that I mourn in Hope. My heart is filled with hope to the fact that He is aware of every calamity that is propelling now and that I also know He is in complete control.

Plague of my heart

The Lord taught me and is still teaching me during these unprecedented times that unless I know the plague of my own heart, I will not be able to extend and contribute my prayers for others.
