A week long fasting and prayer was conducted at Shelter House from September 25 to October 1, 2017, with morning and evening sessions everyday. The month of September was declared as the Month of Prayer and the Church meditated on innumerable things on prayer and was well-equipped and ready to take on the prayer week. From the very first session, the power of the Lord filled each one gathered mightily. The next set of sessions was taken over by Pastor Stephen from Madurai. The Lord confirmed His word from Exodus 14:30 "That day the Lord saved Israel from the hands of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians lying dead on the shore." It was evident that all the attacks of the enemy over our lives, the causes that have hindered our progress and increase, would be seen lying powerless on the shore in Jesus' name.

The last sessions were a real turnpoint, it was that next level prayer our hearts ached for, our spirits longed for. With Dr. Jebaraj Samuel to preach, there was a mighty release of God's anointing and power that was long due in the Church. The word of God, apt for the end time revival to begin in the city of Bangalore, especially to start through us, came at the very command of the Lord. The Church was brought to the knees at His word, in complete surrender to the mission of the Lord. There was an impartation of God's anointing, burden and glory that set the entire flock of Shelter House Church gathered there on that day of prayer on fire for the Lord never to turn back ever again.

The final day of fasting on October 1, the Church was jam-packed. The Lord gave a second call to all of us to come back to the waiting Lord, to come back to the calling He has called us for and many of us did heed to His call. It was a day of joy and gratitude for all the Lord's mercies towards Shelter House and His servant in being with us for every single session on each of these days of prayer.

Thousand tongues are not enough to praise God for all that He did. Where would I start, where would I end? A life in this world, me seeing this day, being in good health, a nine year old to call me 'dad', cohesive family, a decent profession, a roof for shade, the daily bread – none of these are by my might nor by my power, but by His grace. The manager (actually a mentor) to whom I reported for years, in my first company used to say 'Winston, you are a self-made man'; and I took lot of pride in that feedback, as I did cross many hurdles, sweat till my glands go dry, burned the midnight oil relentlessly, to climb the corporate ladder. Those were the days where I used to believe 'work is worship' and 'career is key', as and when I got time from work, I checked the 'church' box - more as a formality and for the eyes of the society. Seldom did I realize "Heaven and earth



will pass away, but His words will not", what mattered was the year end 'word' (i.e., feedback and rating) and associated appraisal.

Years passed by, pay slips saw increases, responsibilities grew, showcases saw mementos, team size doubled but all those didn't stay for long, very close to a decade I hit saturation. The work that gave all the 'heights', started seeing the 'troughs', future became a question mark, mind never rested – a state of insomnia, when all hope is lost, I looked up to the Lord – there was immense amount of shame and guilt that I was seeking Him only when I needed help, I repented. The one who was a secondary priority all this while, became the primary. Uprooting the family and moving to a new city/state wasn't easy but with a huge leap of faith, we relocated. Not even a week at the new office, I just couldn't find my feet. I came home and never wanted to go back to the office, I didn't sleep, calibrated resignation but who will hire anyone who resigned a company in one week? That was the time when no human could offer help but the comfort and strength came from above. I showed up to office with a new zeal, things gradually changed, year end arrived, I was awarded the top 'CVTPG' ranking - 'consistently very top of the peer group' and was chosen to travel and lead a project in Australia, and won many other accolades. Then moved to another Big 4 organization, went to US etc. But from a spiritual aspect we couldn't settle at a church that quenched our thirst for God and centers around His word.

How to Preserve the Habit of Reading the Bible

The very important thing in our life being a disciple of our Lord Jesus is to eat our spiritual food (ie the Word of God) and keep our spiritual life healthy. But are we keeping "Bible Reading" as a discipline in our life? No, not always. We do miss reading Bible some times and we give lame excuses to God. But these excuses will develop cancer inside our spiritual life and make our spirit unhealthy. In this world, we sometimes eat polluted and adulterated food likewise when we eat our spiritual food by reading Bible we pollute it by adding distractions like watching TV, spending time in social network, attending phone calls while reading Bible, not meditating upon the Word of God but reading it just for the sake of doing it and sometimes we don't read Bible at all.



To overcome all these distractions we need to follow these three methods so that we can improvise our Bible reading:

1. HAVE A BIBLE READING PLAN:

"Bible is meant to be bread for daily use not cake for special occasion."

Starting a Bible reading is like starting a new diet. Changing your diet takes discipline. You may find it difficult when you start but if the Bible reading plan is followed daily, it will make your spirit fit and healthy. So follow a Bible reading plan properly.

2. FOLLOW SOAP BIBLE STUDY METHOD:

Scripture: Write down one Scripture that was meaningful to you

Observations: See what was interesting in the passage, what did you learn and what was God saying to you.

Application: Check how you can apply this Scripture to your life and how will you let it change you.

<u>Prayer:</u> Respond to God in prayer, use the Scripture as the guide. Ask God to help you meditate and apply the Scripture to your life.

When the above four steps are followed, you will find the Bible reading interesting and you could explore more about what God wants to talk to you.

3. APPLY 5 P BIBLE STUDY METHOD:

- 1. POSITION yourself to hear from God
- 2. POUR over the passage
- 3. PULL out the spiritual principles
- 4. POSE the questions
- 5. PLAN obedience

Try applying the above 5 P Method so improvise your Bible Reading so that we can begin to think like how God thinks.

1 Corinthians 2:16 "But we have the mind of Christ." When the Holy Spirit comes into the believer he receives "the Spirit of sound mind." (1 Tim 1:7) We will have the capacity to think in accordance to God's word. So, let's take an oath to enhance and improvise our Bible reading. Amen!!

Laughter - A good medicine


Six-year-old Angie and her fouryear-old brother Joel were sitting together in church.
