
What is a Christian Home?

That was the last thing my great grandmother, dear Mrs. Alagubai Pandian told me before she rested in the Lord at the age of 98. Being a Brahmin, she found the Lord Jesus in her late twenties. As her faith grew, she found that the Lord speaks through His word and spent her time in reading and learning more of the Bible. She has finished

You can hear her timely warning to keep away from corruption and evil no matter how popular or profitable it was.

Till that night she rested in the Lord she lived her life in the ways of God and therefore she was fearless.
